A child care agreement is a written document that specifies all the necessary information for a guardian and a child care provider to get into the business. Before beginning any work, both parties must sign a contract that lays out all the terms and conditions regarding child care.

Contracts and Policies. Family child care providers are generally free to construct their own contract with parents of the children in their care. There are two exceptions: Some state licensing rules define what should be in your contract, so check with your local licensor before finalizing your agreement. Federal anti-discrimination laws make it illegal for providers to discriminate in their contract on the basis of race, color, gender,
