The Urim and Thummim (Heb. אֲרִימִּים תֻּמִּימִּים) was a priestly device for obtaining oracles. On the high priest's ephod (an apron-like garment) lay a breastpiece (חֹשֶׁן) – a pouch inlaid with 12 precious stones engraved with the names of the 12 tribes of Israel – that held the Urim and Thummim (Ex. 28:15–30; Lev. 8:8).

The Urim and Thummim originated in Egypt and in ancient Egypt a breastplate was better known as a Pectoral and was a brooch.
