The first verbs you should introduce are those that are both common and easily pronounced such as eat, run and take. Verbs that aren't commonly used in conversations or in the reading material of your students should be avoided. Use Groups. Cooperative groups is a teaching strategy based on students helping students. The group should be heterogeneous and have a mixture of students with different abilities.
